

## **Montana Department of Transportation Public Hearing and Comments: Transit DBE Goal Setting**

Montana Department of Transportation (MDT) is hosting a public hearing on the proposed overall Disadvantaged Business Enterprise (DBE) goal for Federal Transit Administration (FTA) funded contracts and to provide an opportunity for public comments and verbal testimony.

MDT is proposing a DBE goal of **0.26%** for Federal Fiscal Year 2018-2020, to be achieved through race-neutral means.

The public hearing is scheduled for June 13, 2017 from 10:30 to 11:30 am and can be attended in person or by webinar.
