Project scope: 0.5 miles of new Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) compliant shared-use path along High School Drive south of Lame Deer on the Northern Cheyenne Reservation. The project extends an existing section of shared-use path and provides a safe and convenient non-motorized connection from Lame Deer to the Lame Deer Junior High and High School. The project includes: 10-ft wide asphalt shared-use path, ADA ramps, retaining walls, drainage improvements, lighting, signing, striping, and revegetation.
