## Montana Transportation Alternatives Program Sidewalks – Twin Bridges TA 29(56) UPN 9443000



<u>Project scope:</u> 2,200 feet of new Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) compliant sidewalk and curb ramps, upgraded curb ramps to Standards, 1,000 feet of new curb and gutter, crosswalks, ADA parking spaces, signing, and revegetation. The project is along 5<sup>th</sup> Avenue from Main Street to Bridge Street; Bridge Street from 5<sup>th</sup> Avenue to 6<sup>th</sup> Avenue; on the south side of 6<sup>th</sup> Ave from Main Street to west of the school gymnasium building; the north side of 6<sup>th</sup> Avenue from the alley west of Main Street to Bridge Street; along the school bus loading/unloading zone along Wray Street, and along the south side of 8<sup>th</sup> Avenue from Wray Street to the approach to the school. The purpose of the project is to construct ADA compliant sidewalks to safety route pedestrians to and from the Twin Bridges School.
