
FOURCHETTE CREEK RESEVOIR

BACKGROUND INFORMATION

The Fourchette Creek Reservoir Complex was constructed in the Missouri River Breaks in 1997 and is considered the first attempted wetland mitigation site in Montana. The project was constructed to mitigate wetland impacts associated with Montana Department of Transportation (MDT) projects constructed in Watershed #9 (Middle Missouri River Basin). The site is located approximately 15 miles southwest of Sun Prairie in Phillips County. It was constructed on Bureau of Land Management (BLM) lands northwest of the Charles M. Russell National Wildlife Refuge. This restoration project was anticipated to provide approximately 10 acres of mitigation.

WETLAND VEGETATION

Dominant wetland vegetation

Five types of communities were observed:

- Type 1- Foxtail barley/Spike rush (Hordeum jubatum/Eleocharis spp.)
- Type 2- Water milfoil / Pondweed (Myriophyllum spp./Potamogeton spp.)
- Type 3- Foxtail barley/ Wheatgrass (Hordeum jubatum/Agropyron spp.)
- Type 4- Saltmarsh bulrush/ Broad-leaf cattail (Scirpus maritimus/Typha latifolia)
- **Type 5** Rough cocklebur (*Xanthium strumarium*)
