


Historically Native Americans fatalities represented between 11.8% and 19.7% of all Montana fatalities

Native Americans make up only 6.2% of the population




Native American Fatalities






Native American Fatalities by Age






Native American Fatalities by Gender






Native American Fatalities – Protection Use
