



Montana Data Facts

- Roadway departure crashes have accounted for 67% of all Montana's roadway fatalities.
- Impaired drivers involved crashes have accounted for 43% of all Montana's roadway fatalities.

57% of all Montana roadway fatalities involved unrestrained occupants.

Montana Data Facts

- 82% of fatalities and serious injuries occurred on rural area roadways.
- Friday, Saturday, and Sunday account for almost half (49%) of all fatal and serious injuries.
- The three months of June, July, and August account for 35% of all fatalities and serious injuries.


