# CHSP Overview

- In 2006 MT developed first Comprehensive Highway Safety Plan
- Multidisciplinary approach to safety
- Focus on areas with most potential for reduction in fatalities and injuries
- Developed and prioritized safety strategies
- 2009 Goal: Halve fatalities and serious injuries by 2030





