WHAT IS PRISM?

- PRISM is a partnership between the Federal Motor Carrier Safety Administration (FMCSA) and the states to promote and enhance motor carrier safety.
- A requirement for the United States Department of Transportation (USDOT) number and Taxpayer Identification Number(TIN) to be provided on these forms for each vehicle being registered.
- A requirement to specify whether the carrier responsible for the safety of a vehicle is expected to change during the registration year.
- A requirement to update the company's census data (form MCS 150) with FMCSA every two years.
- Vehicles associated with a carrier that has been placed out of service by FMCSA will be denied IRP registration until the out of service condition has been satisfied.

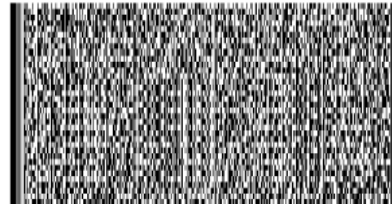

Montana Overlength Permit Restrictions

Must comply with all laws and Administrative Rules of Montana 18,8,101 thru 18,8,1101

Continuous travel allowed during the hours of darkness, weekends, holidays, and on red route highways. Lights must be displayed the full length and width of load. Extreme caution in the operation of the motor vehicle shall be exercised when hazardous conditions such as snow, ice, sleet, fog, mist, rain, dust or smoke adversely affect visibility or traction. Speed shall be reduced when such conditions exist. The driver of any vehicle equipped with vehicular hazard warning lights may activate such lights whenever necessary to warn the operators of the following vehicles of the presence of a traffic hazard ahead of the signaling vehicle, or to warn the operators of other vehicles that the signaling vehicle may itself constitute a traffic hazard. When conditions become sufficiently dangerous, the company or the operator shall discontinue operations, and operations shall not be resumed until the vehicle can be safely operated. No travel is allowed when a route has been placed under severe driving conditions as determined by the Department of Transportation. The Department of Transportation road report is available 24 hours a day by calling Montana 511 or by calling (800) 225-7523. The road report can also be found on the MT Department of Transportation internet site at www.mdt.mt.gov. The total responsibility for protection of the public using the highway shall be assumed by the permittee.

- The Registrant should notify the Helena JRP Office within 10 business days of any Legal Name, FEIN/ TIN and/or Address Changes. This information should also be updated on your MCMS / MCS-150 on the FMCSA web site.
- The Registrant must notify the Helena IRP Office within 10 business days if the Motor Carrier Responsible for Safety changes on a vehicles long term lease.
- It is the carrier's responsibility to maintain an active USDOT number, even if the carrier is leased on with another company.

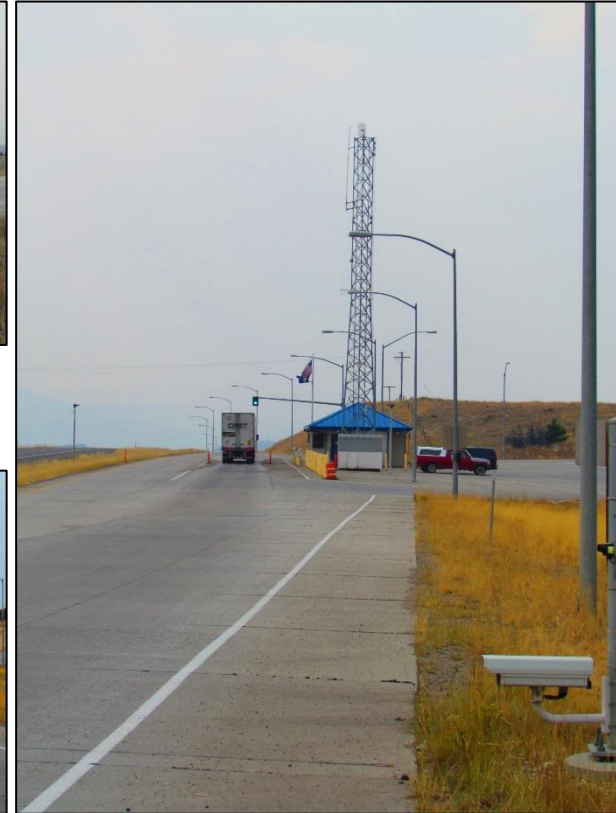
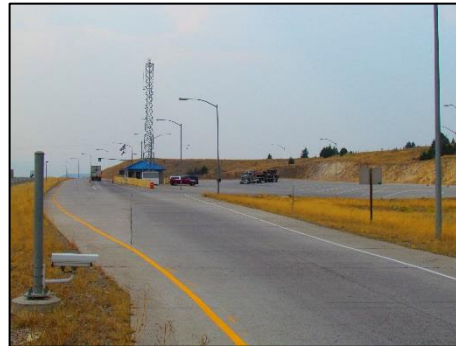
