The Northern Cheyenne Tribe Department of Environmental Protection and Natural Resources (NC DEPNR) has reviewed the notice published in the January 06, 2017 Federal Register on behalf of the Army Corps of Engineers regarding the reissuance of nationwide permits and issuance of new permits, general conditions, and definitions. The Department of Environmental Protection and Natural Resources waiver or denial of each nationwide permit is summarized below:

The Northern Cheyenne Tribe Department of Environmental Protection and Natural Resources (NC DEPNR) waives 401 certification on Nationwide Permits 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 7, 8, 9, 10, 12, 13, 14, 22, 28, 32, 34, 36, 48, 54. The EPD requests notification via email or regular mail of any activities occurring in the permits named above.

The (NC DEPNR) denies 401 certification on Nationwide Permits, 6, 11, 15, 16, 17, 18, 19, 20, 21, 23, 24, 25, 27, 29, 30, 31, 33, 35, 37, 38, 39, 40, 41, 42, 43, 44, 45, 46, 49, 50, 51, 52, and 53.

Upon review the determinations listed above will provide the necessary regulatory mechanisms to protect water quality within the exterior boundaries of the Northern Cheyenne Reservation. If you have any questions, please do not hesitate to contact my office at (406) 477-6506 ext.101.
