The Montana Department of Transportation (MDT) Aeronautics Program invites you to attend the 2027 Aviation Winter Survival Clinic. The clinic will build your confidence in survival preparedness and techniques.

- This clinic is geared toward all aviation pilots and passengers in the event an emergency landing takes place and survival is necessary until help arrives. However, these skills can be used by anyone who finds themselves in a cold-weather survival situation.
- Co-ed, shared-room communal cabins have been reserved for Friday night.
- Event kickoff at 1:30 p.m., Friday, the 8th. Please arrive no later than 12 p.m. It will wrap-up by noon on Sunday, the 10th.
- Friday will consist of classroom instruction until 8 p.m., with a dinner break. Saturday will be spent night outside constructing shelters followed by a camp out in the shelters participants build.
- Meals will be provided, with the exception of Saturday evening, which is bring-your-own dinner for the campout. All meals will be prepared and served family-style by the Lodge. Substitutions will not be available. If you require or desire alternate meals, please bring your own food. There will be a kitchen available in the lodge.
- The cost of meals, lodging, and instruction are all included!
- This remote location is in the mountains. It is an off-grid facility and there is no cell service or Wi-Fi.
