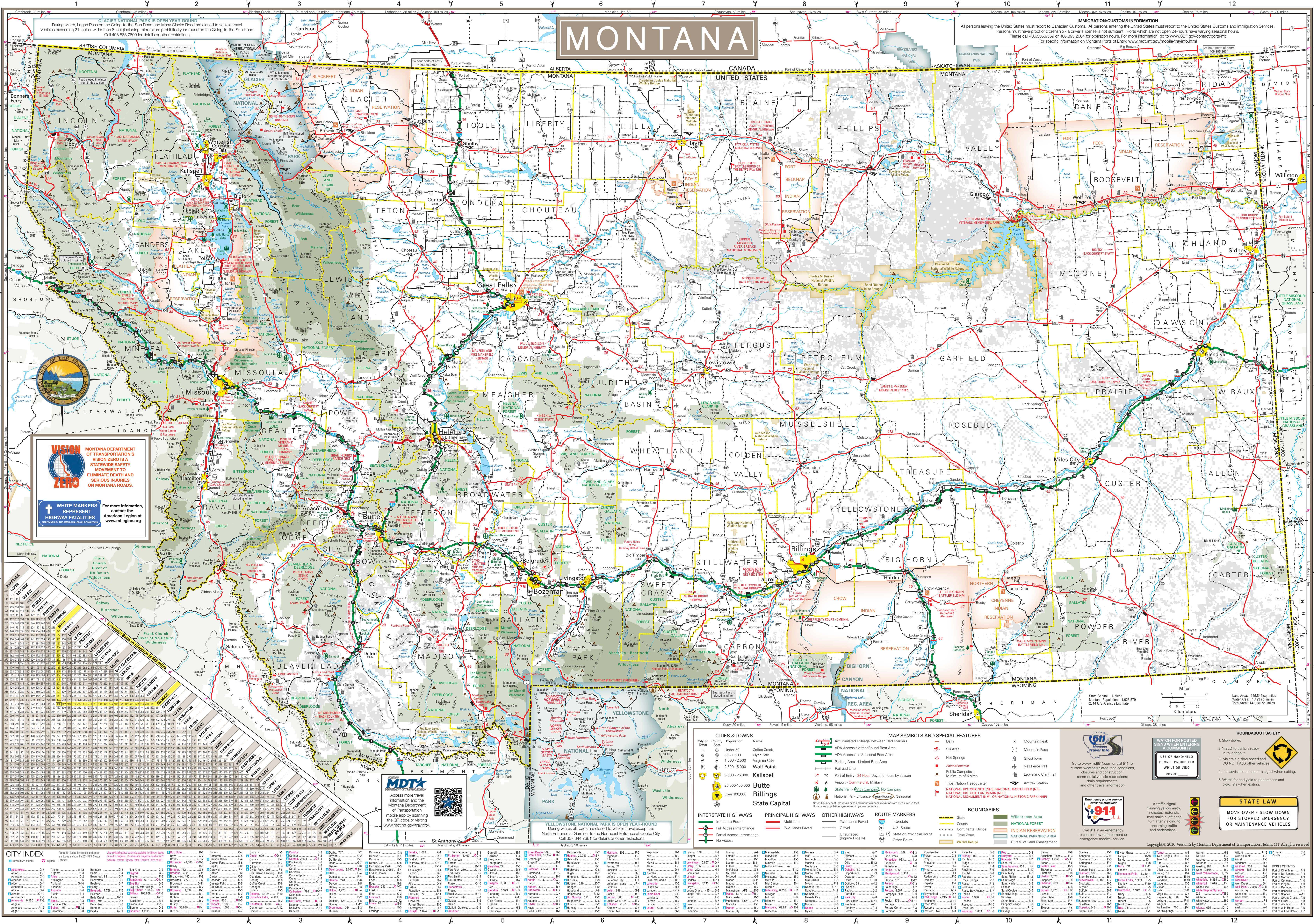

All persons leaving the United States must report to Canadian Customs. All persons entering the United States must report to the United States Customs and Immigration Services. Persons must have proof of citizenship - a driver's license is not sufficient. Ports which are not open 24-hours have varying seasonal hours.
