- Entering projects in RIP (and submitting reports to TRID) is REQUIRED for USDOT-funded research per FHWA guidance and US DOT's Public Access Plan.
- Closing Out Projects:
  - **Mark** RIP record as completed
  - **Submit** final report to TRID at <http://trid.trb.org/submit>
    - Always include [tris-trb@nas.edu](mailto:tris-trb@nas.edu) in your report distribution per [FHWA Guidance](#)
  - **Check** TRID to make sure report has been entered
  - **Wait** 6 months AFTER research is complete
  - **Delete** record from RIP

RIP displays 25 records per page by default. Use the **Records Per Page** selections at the very bottom of the [Additional Search Filters](#) to decrease or increase the number of results displayed per page. Records can be displayed in increments of 10, 25, 50 or 100. After selecting the desired number of records, click the  button to save the setting for your current session.

To navigate more than one page of results, use the arrow buttons at the top and bottom of each page of results. Key in a number to go to a particular page of results.

Note that **Sort Order** can be changed to Descending or Ascending.

Records can also be sorted by:

- **Start Date** - Start Date is the date that a project starts.
- **End Date** - Date that the project was completed.
- **Created Date** - Date that a record was added to RIP.


# Datasets Indexed in TRID!

- In search results: [supporting dataset] OR [dataset] at end of ***Title*** field
- ***Dataset URLs*** in both Dataset record and final report record if applicable
- Dataset limit is now available: ***Result Type***

  - Current and upcoming projects related to the topic
  - Names of Committees working on relevant issues
  - Upcoming events such as conferences and webinars
- Updated at least annually; you'll find a date stamp on the first page of every document.
- The TRB Library can provide updates to existing Snap Searches or create new documents for TRB Sponsors.
