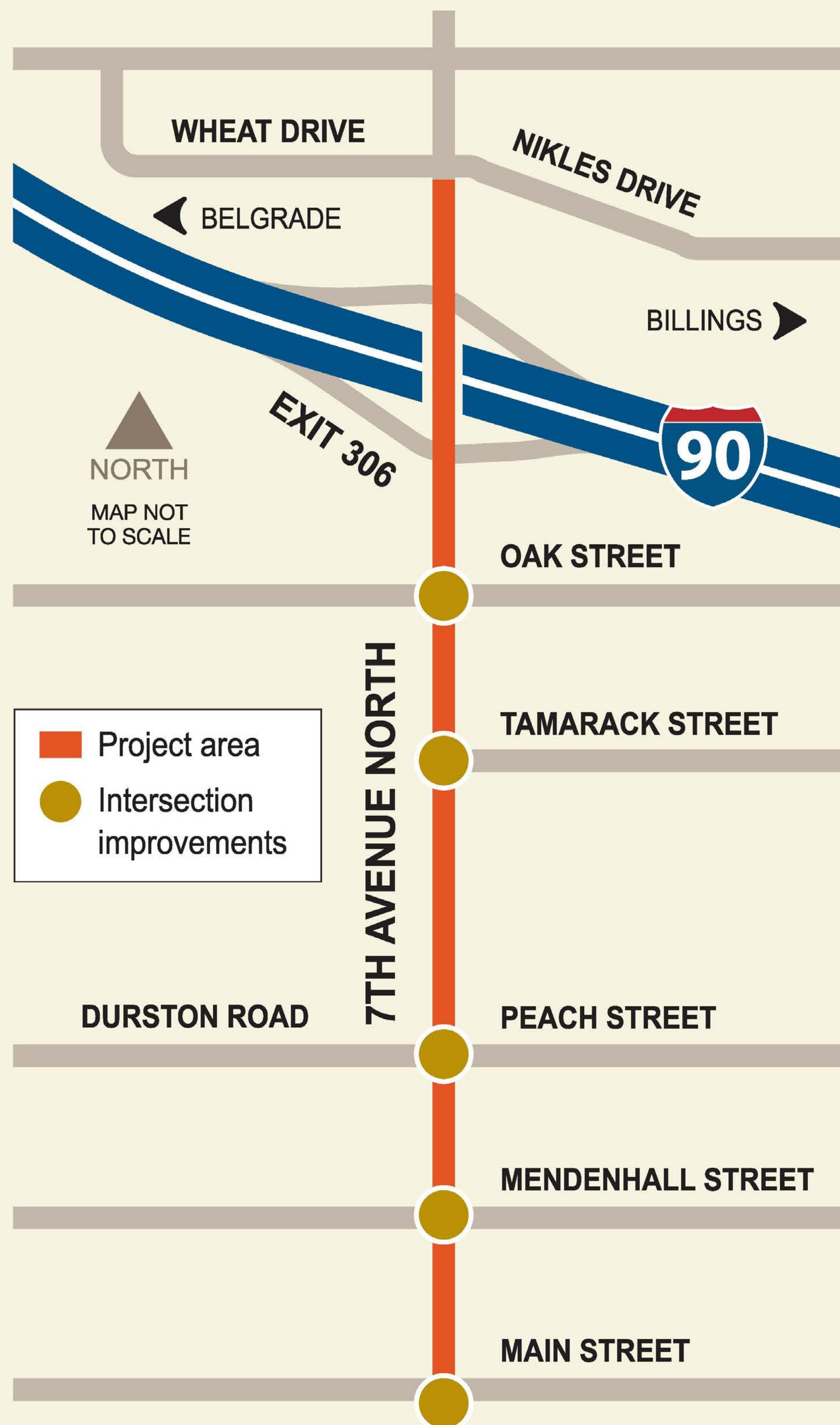

# Project Overview



The 7th Avenue North Intersections project will extend the service life of the roadway, improve traffic flow, and enhance pedestrian safety features in a high-traffic area along 7th Avenue North between West Main Street and the intersection with Nikles Drive/ Wheat Drive.

Additionally, this project will widen Peach Street and Oak Street near 7th Avenue North to better facilitate the flow of traffic.

# Anticipated Schedule

Construction is anticipated to begin in July, and most of the work will be completed in a single season.

Crews expect to return to apply a seal and cover (chip seal) and final pavement markings in 2026.







# Planned Improvements

## Intersections



Intersections at Main Street, Mendenhall Street, Durston Road/Peach Street, Tamarack Street, and Oak Street will have their signals upgraded to better facilitate the flow of traffic.

Additionally, the Oak Street intersection will be widened to restore the shoulder, and Peach Street will be widened to add a dedicated westbound turn lane.



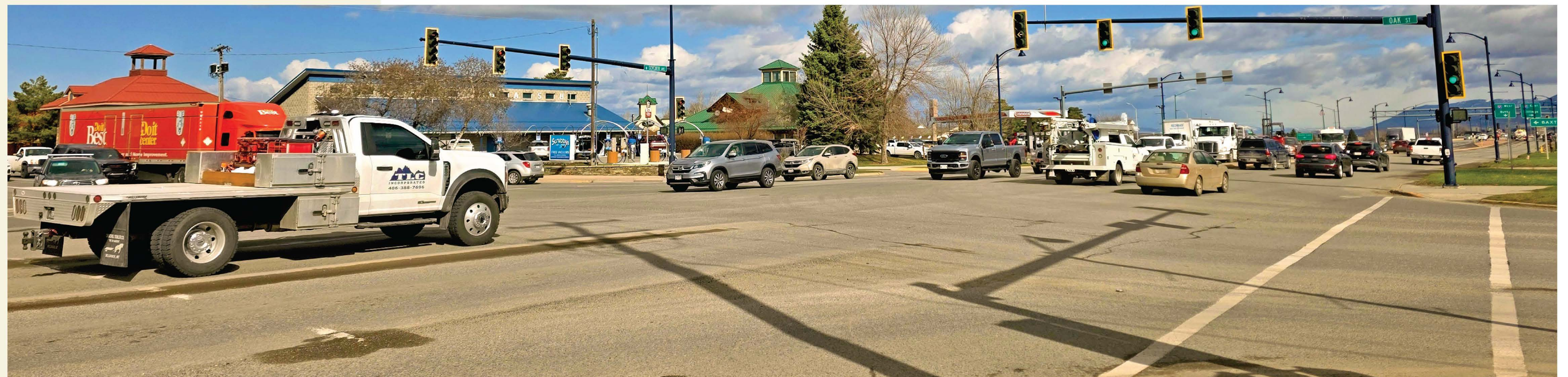


# Planned Improvements

## Roadway

7th Avenue North will be milled and paved to remove the existing, deep ruts and extend the service life of the road.

In 2026, crews are expected to return to apply a seal and cover (chip seal) and final pavement markings.







# Planned Improvements

## Safety Enhancements/ADA



Sidewalks and pedestrian signals in the project area will be upgraded to Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) guidelines.





# What to Expect During Construction

During construction, motorists should expect:

- Intersection sidewalk closures and pedestrian detours
- Brief on-street parking disruptions during pavement work
- Flaggers may direct traffic at times
- Temporary nighttime lane closures
- Reduced speed limits
- Delays of up to 15 minutes
- Wide loads may be restricted at times







# Business Access

At least one access to businesses in the work zone will remain open throughout construction.







## Next Steps



Communication with the public during construction is important to the success of this project.

MDT will provide updates to the community through print, digital and in-person outreach as project work begins, and at key points during construction.
