



Choteau North U.S. 89 Road Improvements

PROJECT OVERVIEW

The Choteau North Project will **widen and realign** U.S. Highway 89 in Teton County as part of ongoing efforts to improve safety on the roadway. Design is currently underway, and construction is anticipated for 2023.

Specific roadway improvements include:

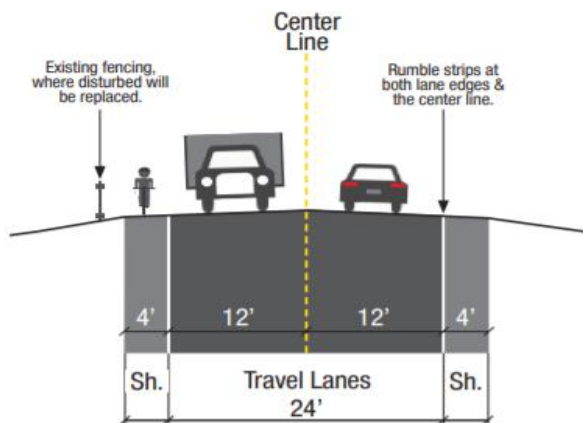
- Widening U.S. 89 from 24-foot wide to 32-foot wide – one 12-foot-wide lane in each direction with 4-foot wide shoulders.
- Improving the roadway by flattening the steep slopes (shoulders) on the side of the road, straighten curves, and reducing the vertical dips.
- Resetting two historical markers:
 - Old Agency on the Teton.
 - Blackfeet and Buffalo.
- Updating signage and pavement markings.
- Shoulder rumble strips will be placed adjacent to the lane edge, and centerline rumble strips will be incorporated into this project for safety. Placing low-noise shoulder rumble strips adjacent to the lane edge and incorporating centerline low-noise rumble strips into this project for safety. Sinusoidal, low-noise, rumbles are quieter than the normal rumble strips because they are cut less deep.
- Improving drainage.

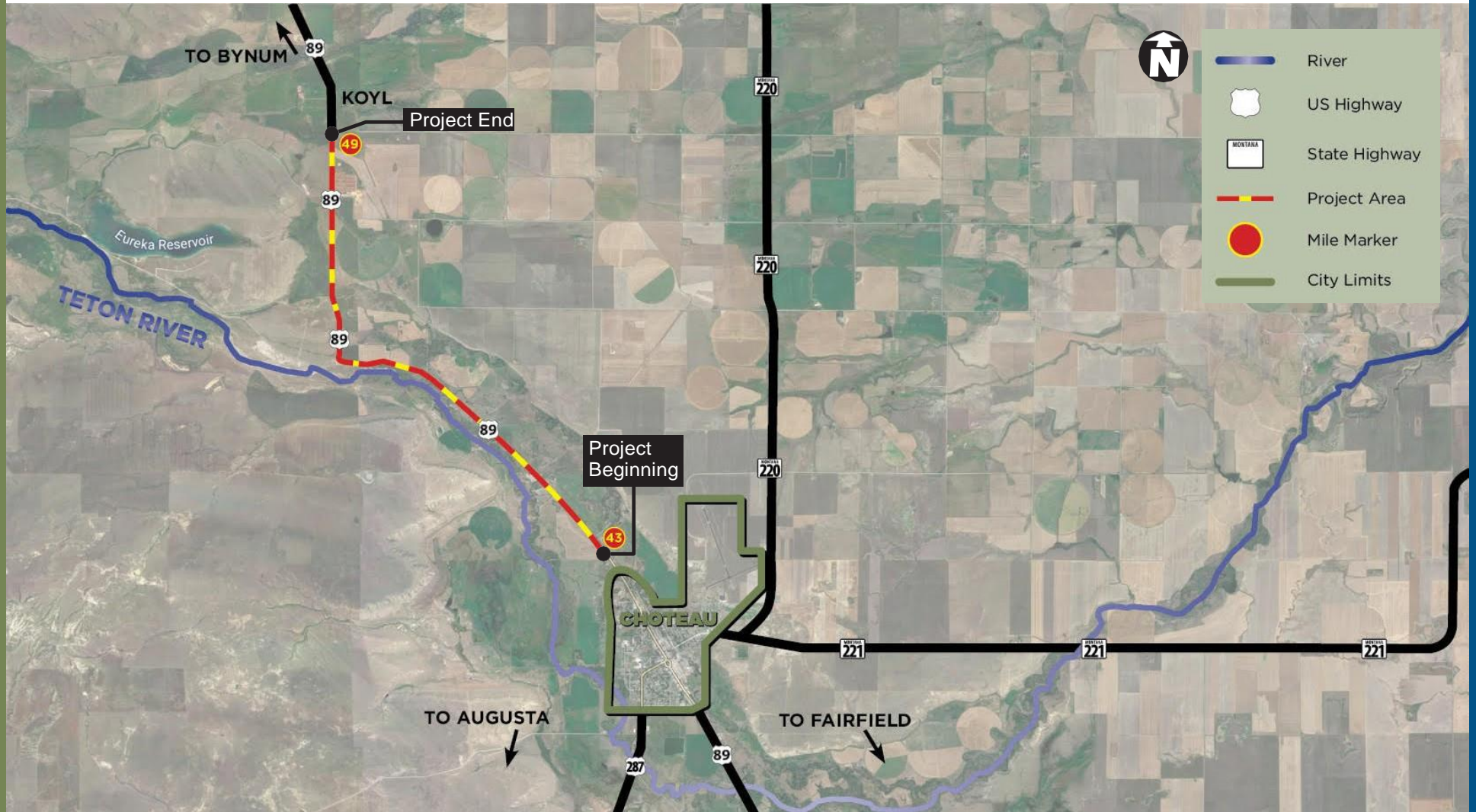


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PROJECT AREA MAP



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
