


FAST FACTS:

Learn about the intersection of MT 83 and MT 200



Our Goal:

The Montana Department of Transportation aims to reconfigure the intersection to improve safety and traffic flow for all highway users.

TRAFFIC STATS:



The intersection is home to one of the most frequently visited boat check stations in the state, as well as a busy weigh station and rest area, contributing significantly to traffic issues.



During summer months and holiday weekends, long lines of cars develop on MT 83, causing traffic delays.

850

Heavy and commercial vehicles per day contribute to traffic during the busy season.



Traffic at the intersection has grown 2.11% per year over the last five years. If this rate continues, by 2045 a summer day could yield as many as 12,000 vehicles.

CRASH STATS:

35 reported crashes between 2003 and 2019

Of these crashes,
1 resulted in a fatality
12 resulted in injuries
22 resulted in property damage only
