[.] Nine (9) projects were advertised a total of twenty-four (24) bids were tendered. Staff recommends awarding projects 101, 103,104,105,106,107,108 and 109 to the responsive low bidders. Project 102 is outside of guidelines for award and will be repackaged for a future letting.

Commissioner Lambert moved to approve the staff recommendation to award projects 101, 103, 104, 105, 106, 107, 108, and 109 as recommended by staff to responsive low bidders. Commissioner Belcourt seconded the motion, all Commissioners voted aye.

Commissioner Jergeson questioned project 102, NHPB 315-5(15)1, NHPB 15-4(163)209, NHPB-HSIP 15-4(164)218, NHPB 15-4(166)234 and the response for justification asking if the department receive Chad's (Sletten's) prior to the response. Why was there no response to the Sletten response from the department? Kevin Christensen responded that the department is not seeing steel prices increase and used the Broadus Interchange project as example, discussed high bids, mobilization and zones for the project.

Commissioner Jergeson moved to approve project 102, the motion failed due to lack of second.

Meeting adjourned at 9:35 a.m.
