2. MT 16 Glendive Speed Limit Recommendation

Dwane Kailey briefed the Commission concerning the oversite of the requested 40 mph speed limit request in the Dawson County & Montana Highway Patrol letters.

Commissioner Sansaver moved to rescind the Transportation Commission approval of the MT 16 Glendive North Speed limit, Commissioner Sanders seconded the motion, Commissioners Sansaver, Fisher, Sanders and Frazier voted aye, Commissioner Aspenlider voted nye.

Dwane Kailey presented the MT 16 Glendive North speed limit as requested by Dawson County and clarified the 40 mph and distance from Towne Street to Olmstead Lane.

Commissioner Aspenlider stated that it was not a good position for the Commission to set the precedence of following what is not supported in the engineering study and if challenged there was not a traffic study that supported the Commission decision.

Commissioner Sansaver moved to rescind the Transportation Commission approval of the MT 16 Glendive North Speed limit, Commissioner Sanders seconded the motion, Commissioners Sansaver, Fisher, Sanders and Frazier voted aye, Commissioner Aspenlider voted nye.
