

The Montana Department of Transportation (MDT) will reconstruct a section of Secondary 232 (S 232), commonly known as Wild Horse Trail, near Havre. Proposed reconstruction includes wider shoulders, straighter curves, flattened hills, and new pavement from 4th Avenue North to Road 60 North. Planned reconstruction activities will improve vehicle travel in the area.

Project development is underway and 60% plans were completed in late 2021. Final design is anticipated during the fall of 2023.

MDT will work closely with nearby property owners and stakeholders during project design. There will be several opportunities to engage with the project team, and MDT encourages you to get involved, share your input and learn more about this important project.
