MT Highway 84 is an important thoroughfare for residents and tourists accessing the Madison River or commuting to business in nearby Bozeman. This two-lane highway, with its hilly terrain and curves following the river, has proved to have more crashes on it than the statewide average for similar highways.

The Montana Department of Transportation (MDT) is working hard to improve safety for all Highway 84 travelers by conducting the **Highway 84 – East of Norris Corridor Study**. MDT has hired consultant Morrison – Maierle to explore and identify the best safety solutions for the highway.
