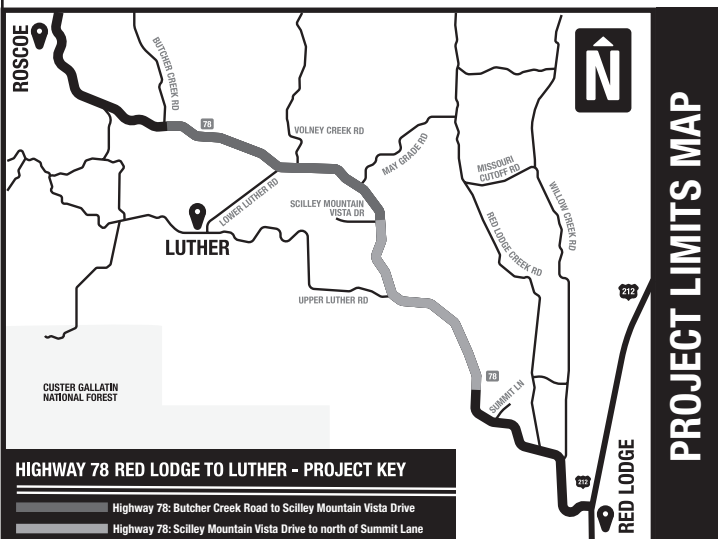

RED LODGE TO LUTHER

Dear Carbon County Friends and Neighbors,

The Montana Department of Transportation (MDT) is working to improve safety for all Highway 78 travelers between Red Lodge and Luther.



Roadway designs are being developed to reduce the roller coaster effect and increase sight distance. Hwy 78 shoulders will be widened to four feet on each side and pull out areas will be added. In total, nearly 11 miles of roadway will be improved.

MDT is in the early stages of designing these improvements. **Before construction can begin, public feedback is needed to help shape the future of Highway 78.** Community input helps to ensure these projects meet the needs of daily commuters like you.
