

I-94 Rest Area Corridor Study

The Montana Department of Transportation (MDT) invites you to attend a public meeting to discuss the I-94 Rest Area Corridor Study.

The study examines existing and proposed rest areas within the I-90 corridor from Big Timber to Columbus and the I-94 corridor from Billings to Miles City. The purpose of the study is to assess the current condition of rest area locations, determine the feasibility of upgrading existing facilities, and prioritize proposed improvements. Findings and recommendations from the study will be discussed at the meeting, including the proposal to construct a new rest area at Fort Keogh.
