Eight bridges are located on Montana Highway 81 (MT 81) between the intersections with Montana Highway 80 (MT 80), west of Denton, and US Highway 191 (US 191), north of Lewistown. The other three structures are located on Secondary Highway 400 (S 400) southwest of Hobson, Secondary Highway 238 (S 238) southeast of Lewistown, and Secondary Highway 297 (S 297) north of Shawmut.
