


The Montana Department of Transportation (MDT) is designing plans to reconstruct Old Reserve Drive, located in Flathead County to the northwest of Kalispell. The project area is approximately 3 miles, beginning at the intersection with Farm to Market Road and ending approximately 650 feet west of the Stillwater Road intersection. The goal of this project is to reduce the potential occurrence and severity of crashes and provide a new driving surface to last well into the future.



ANTICIPATED SCHEDULE

MDT is currently in the design phase of this project. The project construction schedule will largely depend on right-of-way acquisition and the availability of funding.

Design phase	2023-2024
Right-of-way acquisition	2023-2024
Construction begins	2025 or later
Construction completed	2027 or later

- Reconstructing and realigning nearly 3 miles of Old Reserve Drive.
- Building 8-foot shoulders and flattening the slopes on each side of the road.
- Adding rumble strips to the centerline and shoulder of the road.
- Reducing the grade of steep hills and flattening vertical curves.
