

## Safety benefits of roundabouts

- > Low speeds (due to geometric configuration)
- Vehicles typically travel at similar speeds
- > Crash frequency and severity typically less than other intersections
- One directional flow (counterclockwise)
- Yield on entry (all approaches)
- Pedestrians cross one direction of traffic at a time
- > Right angle, left-turn, and head-on collisions unlikely




Figure 2: 32 vehicle conflict points Source: FHWA Roundabouts: An Informational Guide




Figure 1: Eight vehicle conflict points Source: FHWA Roundabouts: An Informational Guide

A study of 19 higher-speed rural intersections (speed limits of 40 mph or higher) that originally had stop si in all crashes and an 85 percent reduction in injury crashes (*Isebrands & Hallmark*, 2012).
