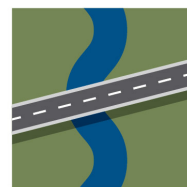




SMITH CREEK BRIDGE REPLACEMENT

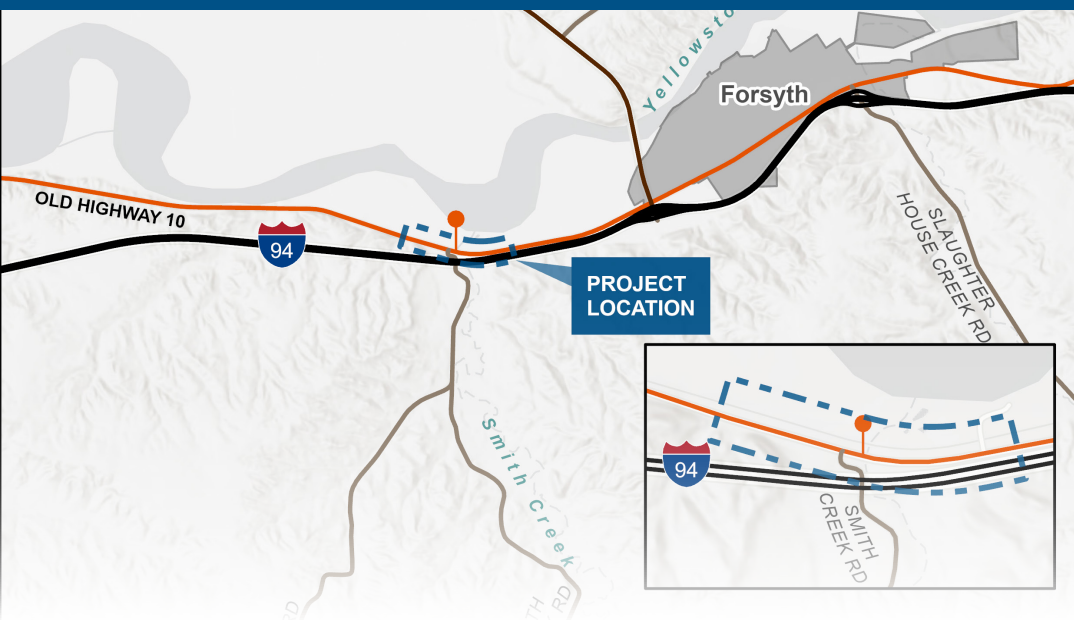


Construction is slated to begin in 2024.

The Montana Department of Transportation (MDT) will replace the existing structure over Smith Creek on Old Highway 10, one mile west of Forsyth. This project is in the preliminary design phase. When constructed, it will include:

- Replacement of the existing structure
- Two 12-foot lanes and 4-foot shoulders on each side
- Minor road work to tie into the bridge on each end
- Guardrail replacement within the project limits
