DEAR TARGHEE PASS HIGHWAY FRIENDS AND NEIGHBORS,

As you know, US 20 is a well-traveled corridor, transporting local traffic as well as numerous visitors to Yellowstone National Park or other recreation in the area. Unfortunately, this highway has a rear-end crash pattern west of Denny Creek Road.

The Montana Department of Transportation (MDT) is working to address these crashes through the Targhee Turn Lanes project. Engineers have been creating project plans over the past year and the public is now invited to learn more and provide comments on this work.

Attend the Targhee Turn Lanes open house to meet with project staff, give your feedback and ask questions! No formal presentation will be made and all are welcome to attend at any time between 4 and 7 p.m. on July 14. COVID-19 prevention measures such as social distancing and masks are recommended for unvaccinated people, per CDC guidelines.
