CONSTRUCTION AHEAD

The Montana Department of Transportation (MDT) and LHC Inc. are rehabilitating approximately 4 miles of U.S. Highway 2 (US 2) between Rose Crossing and the Glacier Park International Airport near Kalispell. This project begins south of the Rose Crossing intersection and ends just south of the entrance to Glacier International Airport.



PLANNED IMPROVEMENTS INCLUDE:

- Removing and replacing the pavement
- Adding a seal and cover (chip seal)
- Crack sealing roadway shoulders and median lane
- Adding a fog seal
- Upgrading existing curb ramps at Rose Crossing intersection
- Resurfacing Motor Carrier Services weigh station
- Electrical upgrades to Birch Grove Road and Rose Crossing intersections
- Adding shoulder rumble strips, new pavement markings, signage, and roadside delineators
- Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) upgrades at the intersection with Rose Crossing

WHY IS THE PROJECT NEEDED?

This corridor experiences significant daily traffic volumes and over time it has become worn down and formed grooves in the driving lanes. This project will address wear and tear on the road and extend the service life of this section of the highway. Additionally, upgrading curb ramps to current ADA compliance and upgrading signals and signage will enhance pedestrian and vehicle safety.

WHAT TO EXPECT DURING CONSTRUCTION

Construction is anticipated to begin in June and be completed by fall.

When construction begins, motorists can expect:

- One lane in each direction will remain open at all times.
- Speed limits will be reduced.
- Work may take place 24 hours a day, Monday through Saturday. Sunday work may be approved by the project manager on a case-by-case basis if requested by the contractor.
- Rose Crossing and Birch Grove Road intersections will be closed to east/west traffic for up to a 5-day period. These closures will not occur simultaneously, and a detour will be posted during the closures.
- Wide loads may be restricted at times.
- Delays of up to 15 minutes are possible.
