Third Party Procurement Oversight

- We provide oversight on small Capital Projects.
 - Examples include Richland door capital project, facilities, A&E, and minivans.
- Rural Needs Study
 - Opened to the public September 6th, 2024 and will close October 11th, 2024
 - Project Benefits: This effort is intended to help understand the unmet transit needs of the rural areas of Montana to facilitate the expansion of service by the transit agencies.
 - This activity will fund hiring a consultant team to conduct a comprehensive assessment of the scope of work. The scope of work includes the following elements:
 - Surveys across the state to understand the public transportation needs
 - Site visits to rural regions to identify restricted access.
 - Several meetings to discuss the unmet needs.
