#### 2025 Legislature Wrapped Up

The 2025 Legislature wrapped up in Helena last month. With thousands of pieces of legislation proposed, a handful of bills were related to aviation.

HB 487 "Eliminate requirement that the Dept of Transportation have certain divisions". This bill removes the requirement for MDT to have statutorily defined divisions, including the Aeronautics division. This bill allows the agency to better align its services with its core purpose.

**HB 731** "Revise laws related to airports and light aircraft". This bill was tabled in committee after being transmitted to the Senate. This bill would have required publicly funded airports to provide aircraft under 9,000 lbs. with access through the fence at no cost to the aircraft owner, operator, or passengers.

**HB 571** "Revise aeronautics laws related to the use of Automatic Dependent Surveillance Broadcast (ADS-B) information". This bill prohibits the use of ADS-B out as a means for any entity (private or public) to calculate, generate, or collect any fees from aircraft owners or operators who operate aircraft withing the geographic boundaries of the state.

SR 87 was filed with the Secretary of State confirming appointments to the MDT Aeronautics Board. Reappointments: New Chair Tim Robertson (Montana Association of Counties), Vice Chair Wade Cebulski (Montana Pilot's Association), Gregory Smith (Montana Association of Arial Applicators), and Grayson Sperry (Chamber of Commerce). Tim Damrow (Montana Airport Management Association) is a new appointment. All were appointed to serve a term ending January 3, 2029.

**SB 493** "Establish the offense of trespass by unmanned aerial vehicle". This bill establishes and enforces trespass by an unmanned aerial vehicle to operators that fly over private property below 200 feet above ground level without landowner permission. This bill exempts governments, contractors of utility or broadband entities to assess property damage, and those who have a license issued by the FAA and are operating for legitimate business purposes under FAA regulations.

**HB 202** "Generally revise laws related to the unlawful use of aircraft for hunting". This bill was vetoed by the Governor but would have extended the waiting period to hunt after the use of an aircraft, bans the possession of unmanned aerial vehicles while hunting, increases fines and penalties, and includes game birds in the protected species list.

**SB 106** "An act revising laws related to the use of aircraft while hunting". This bill creates the unlawful use of aircraft to spot or locate any game animal within 24 hours of utilizing an aircraft for the purpose of hunting, including drones. Pilots who hunt should refer to the latest hunting regulations for the full update.

# FAA Ensures Availability of 100LL

The Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) has added airport grant assurance 40. It requires an airport owner or operator that made 100-octane low lead aviation gasoline (100LL) available at any time during calendar year 2022 to not restrict or prohibit the sale of or self-fueling with 100LL. The FAA modifies airport grant assurances to reflect new federal requirements as needed.

This requirement remains until Dec. 31, 2030, or the date on which the airport makes available an unleaded aviation gasoline that has been authorized for use by the FAA as a replacement for 100LL for use in nearly all piston-engine aircraft and engine models. The fuel must meet an industry consensus standard that facilitates the safe use, production, and distribution of such unleaded aviation gasoline.

#### **Attention Airport Sponsors**

As a friendly reminder, airport sponsors who were previously awarded a loan or grant from MDT Aeronautics Division are required to complete a status update or project closeout form each year. To be eligible to apply for additional funding in the future, the closeout form or status update must be completed first.

The loan and grant application period opens on July 1 and will close on November 15, 2025.


