## 41st Annual Montana Aviation Conference

The 41st Annual Montana Aviation Conference, hosted by the Aviation Organizations of Montana (AOM), touched down in Billings February 26 to 28, 2026, at the Billings Hotel and Convention Center. Montana's premier aviation gathering once again brought together pilots, mechanics, airport sponsors, industry partners, and aviation enthusiasts for three full days of learning, networking, and celebration.

This year's program featured a packed exhibit hall, keynote luncheons and banquets, and multiple concurrent sessions covering safety, medicine, regulations, backcountry flying, search and rescue, and stories from across Montana's aviation community. The conference also continued its strong emphasis on workforce development, with more than \$63,000 in Montana aviation scholarships presented to students, pilots, and mechanics during the awards luncheon. Additionally, the Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) presented five Wright Brothers Master Pilot Awards and one Charles Taylor Master Mechanic Awards celebrating 50 years of flying or being an aircraft mechanic!

A highlight for mechanics was the MDT Aeronautics Division's long running Mechanic Refresher and Inspection Authorization (IA) Renewal Seminar, held in conjunction with the conference on Friday and Saturday. Mechanics attended to meet their annual IA renewal requirements - continuing a tradition that began in 1963, when Montana became the first state to offer a state sponsored IA renewal course.

Social events and static displays rounded out the schedule, giving attendees time to connect, share ideas, and explore aircraft and services supporting aviation across the state. As always, the conference underscored aviation's critical role in connecting Montana communities and highlighted the partnerships that keep the state's airports, operators, and airways safe and thriving.

The 42nd annual Montana Aviation Conference will be held in Missoula next year.

# Summer Work Sessions



Backcountry airstrip work sessions are a hands on way to help maintain Montana's public-use strips while enjoying time with fellow pilots and aviation enthusiasts. Typical projects include filling gopher holes, mowing, painting, weeding, replacing windsocks, cutting and stacking firewood, repairing fences, and other light maintenance that keeps these airstrips safe and welcoming for all users.

Volunteers are encouraged to bring work gloves and basic hand tools and if you want, bring your camping gear! These work sessions are also a great opportunity to camp out, swap flying stories, help improve some special recreational airstrips, and learn more about backcountry operations from experienced Montana pilots.

\*Please note that the Spotted Bear work session weekend has been shifted in recent years to improve the chances of favorable weather compared to the legacy weekend. As always, all events are weather dependent, so check with Scott before you launch.

## \$10,000 Airport Courtesy Car Grant Open

The Airport Courtesy Car Application period is open from April 1 to May 31. There are three reimbursement grants of up to \$10,000 each available for a courtesy car. A municipality or eligible third party may apply.

If you would like to see a courtesy car at your airport, talk with your airport manager or those in charge of an eligible third party that may receive the grant.

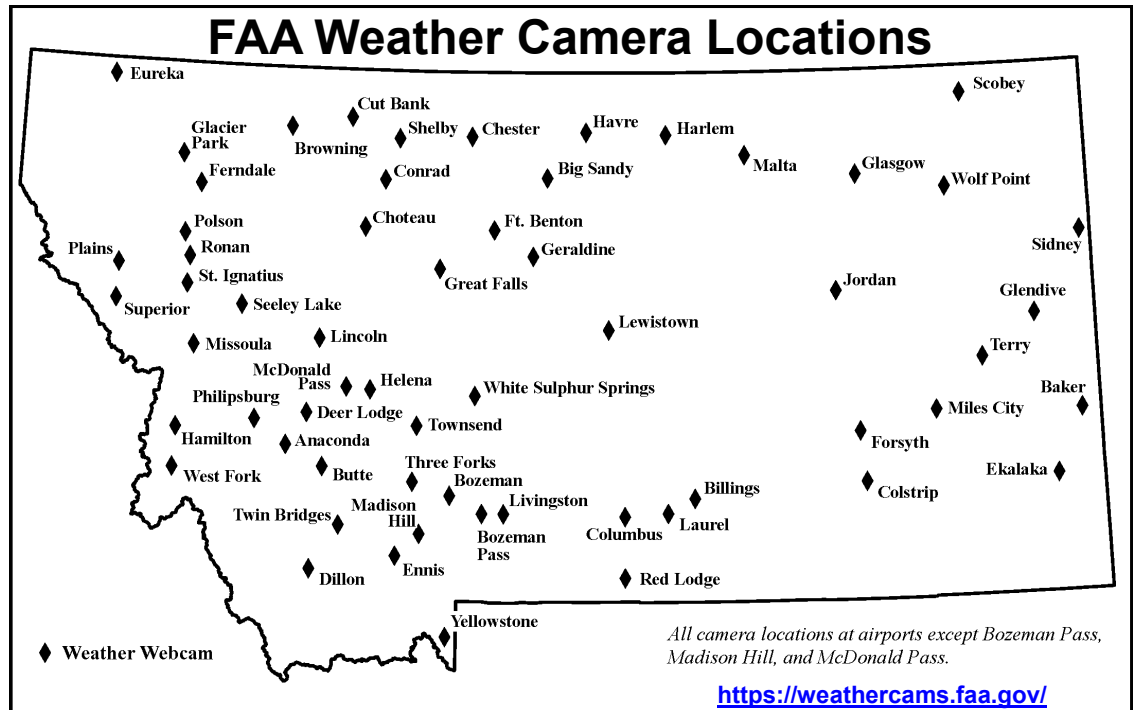
