2020 CHSP Update

A brief update on the 2020 CHSP noting an additional emphasis area to focus on EMS and Emergency Responders was provided by Pam Langve-Davis. The addition of this emphasis area was based on the Advisory Committee discussion that more focus than an overarching strategy needed to be placed on EMS, Emergency Responders, and care of the crash victim along the continuum of care. Given the technical expertise needed to guide this emphasis area team, Alyssa Johnson was asked and accepted the role as chair. In advance of meeting, national emergency service strategies were researched, reviewed, and drafted by the EMS and Trauma Systems core work unit.

Confirmed Strategies & Opportunities Discussion

The draft strategies were defined in advance of the meeting and further discussed and confirmed by the emphasis area team at the meeting.

Emergency Response- After Crash Care Emphasis Area Strategies

- Strategy 1: Access to the Emergency Response System; On- Scene Care Training and Education
- Strategy 2: Safe & Rapid Transport of Crash Victims and Training of Emergency Responders
- Strategy 3: Hospital-Based Trauma Care
- Strategy 4: Integrate Crash, EMS, Trauma and Roadway Surveillance Databases

- Strategy 5: Provide Statewide Injury Prevention Education to Communities through a Collaborative Effort
- Strategy 6: Support Laws, Policy Development and Legislation

Participants further discussed revisions and edits to the strategy purpose statements. Pam Langve-Davis will compile the edits and provide the update to the core work group for review and approval.
